### PARDON: THE INTERRUPTION

Alleluia, Christ is born! The Son of God is with us. We know that God is for us, that he is on our side because he lives with us; he is Emmanuel (God-with-us)! What on earth should we call Christ, call the Son of God?

Isaiah seeing the dark future by the light of prophecy has some ideas: "He will be called wonderful counsellor, mighty God, everlasting father, prince of peace" (Isa 9:6). By his wisdom, Christ is wonderful counsellor to us because he alone knows how best to advise us about our future. By his birth from the Father before all time, he is mighty God because he is Son of God. By his resurrection, he is father and author of everlasting life, a life without death. By his eternal reign, he is prince of peace.

But we can hardly call someone who belongs to the human race by any of those names. Well might we ask whether there is a name of ours which could be worthy of him? My own name means "small": hardly appropriate for a babe of great stature. There are some better possibilities: Matthew means "gift of the LORD"; Andrew means "manly" and thus "courageous". We could search for the best name in our view, but so many of them would refer to Christ himself, when Christ came not to be served but to serve (Matt 20:28).

The only name we can call the holy Child is the one we were told to give him. Jesus means "The LORD saves" and was the name chosen for him by God because "he is the one who will save his people from their sins" (Matt 1:21). This earthly name was chosen for him by God the Father, who thereby claims the Child as his own. And so, the name by which we call the Son of God is more than a name: it is a mission.

The name, Jesus, signals that he is with us as true God in order to save us. As the problem of us finding him a name points out, we are unworthy of him and yet we so need him. We need him to forgive our sins, heal our souls, raise up our minds, bless us with strength. So, this interruption of the Son of God into our lives is a welcome one. He alone can bring us pardon; he it is who will lead us to heaven.

So, it is for us now to kneel before him to receive what he alone can give, babe though he seems for now. May he bless us with the courage and love we need to become the kind of people he created us to be.

To one, to all: merry Christmas!

**ST DOMINIC'S DIVINE MERCY GROUP**


